Hello,

We are working closely with both the Great Barrington Board of Health and Fairview Hospital in preparing for the arrival of the H1N1 vaccine. As you probably have heard there has been a delay in receipt of the vaccine. Despite this delay, we continue to plan for the dispensation of the vaccine. With that in mind we will offer an informational session for parents and public this Thursday evening (October 29<sup>th</sup>) at 7:00 in the community room of the middle school.

Also, we will host immunization clinics in each of our buildings as soon as the vaccine arrives at Fairview. We will hold the first clinic at the elementary school on the first Tuesday after receipt of the vaccine, the second clinic will be at the middle school on the first Wednesday after receipt of the vaccine and the third clinic will be at the high school on the first Thursday after receipt of the vaccine. No one will be turned away on any of the evenings. If you cannot make it to the school that your child is a student in then you will be allowed to go on another evening to one of the other two schools.

The details of time and specific dates will be posted on the district website as soon as we have more information regarding the receipt of the vaccine.
