- 1965 original construction
- 50 acres site
- 110,000 square feet
- 570 students projected
- Served our 20th century students well
- Need to create appropriate space for 21st century learning









MONUMENT MOUNTAIN REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL MSBA ROLE IN PROJECT

- Part of Department of Treasury
- Independent public authority
- Oversees all public school building in the Commonwealth
- Mandates process for planning of projects

 2008/2009 District submitted Statement of Interest to MSBA

- September of 2010 MSBA Board of Directors Invited MMRHS into the program
- Late 2011 early 2012 Project Team selected

- Antiquated Infrastructure
 - 47 year old systems
 - Roof
 - Windows & Doors
 - Heating System
 - Electrical System
 - Plumbing
 - Flooring, wall surfaces, etc
- Security Concerns many points of entry
- Need for Life Safety Upgrades & Hazardous Material Abatement
- Need to Modernize Spaces

 - Guidance






Existing Site





Existing Floor Plan/Option 1


